Consider the career you were allocated and the amount of money you were given each "payday" (when you passed GO). In the real world, would you choose a different career to get more money? Or would you consider a career that paid less but that you enjoyed (there is NO right or wrong answer to this question, different people will have different goals and priorities!)
